Open Forum: Wow, tons of good discussion on short cuts, helpful hints, new and who knows what tools.

Great helpful hints and discussion.

*How to get hot glue out of fabric? An iron and a piece of cotton fabric over the glue, just not on velvet. Test the iron on an inconspicuous spot first. *Glue sticks come in different temps, so make sure you know what you need when ordering your glue sticks.

*Mavis showed her slick new cordless rotary cutter, which can cut up to 10 layers.... of cotton fabric, but is unwavering in comparison to electric scissors which can sometimes veer off line. Easy to handle and saves your hands. Available locally at Harbor Freight, some suppliers may also have them. 2 thumbs up from those who did a test run with the cutter.

*Diana clamps dining room chair seats to her work station with bar clamps to make it easier to remove staples, without the seat creeping across the work station or running the staple remover into her arm. Most stability.

*Foam cutters-the bottom plate comes off with the turn of a screw to make sculpting foam easier.
*Shiv leather to thin it out to make buttons, pound vinyl to thin it out for button making or spray WD40 into the button mold to make release easier.

*Anna brought a tool-see photo- that stumped some. Seems the final consensus is the tool is for cleaning Velcro! Some great door prizes were donated by Geneva, Gina, Zoule and Angela and everyone went home with something.



TIPS



Jim of J Carlson Upholstery in Duluth sent in this tip. He places newspaper under the leather when he sews leather cushions to prevent the leather sticking to the machine table. The newspaper tears off easily after sewing is complete.



When having an open backed chair, Jim hand sews the boxing on the bottom in the welt with a diamond head needle going in and out of the sewing machine holes from sewing the welt to the bottom panel.
